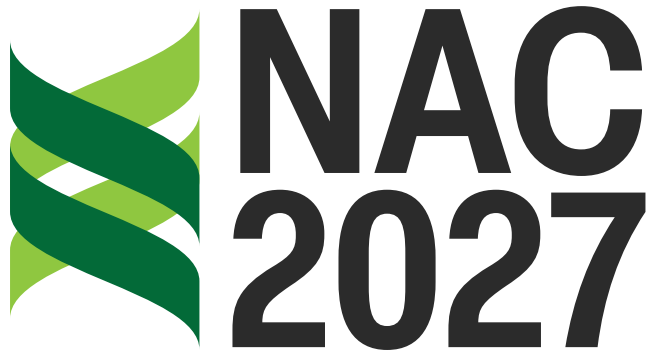

The Australian Amyloidosis Network is pleased to invite sponsors to partner with us for a landmark national program in 2027, bringing together clinicians, researchers, multidisciplinary health professionals, patients and carers across Australia.

The 2027 AAN Conference Program will include two major initiatives:



1. The Inaugural National Amyloidosis Congress 2027, Brisbane (NAC2027)

For the first time, Australia's key amyloidosis opinion leaders, researchers, clinicians and multidisciplinary team members will assemble for a dedicated national medical congress. This one-day meeting will deliver a packed program of practice-changing updates across AL, ATTR and rare amyloid subtypes, with a strong focus on diagnosis, treatment innovation, multidisciplinary care and emerging research.

The Congress will feature leading international experts, including Professor Ashutosh Wechalekar, Dr Mazen Hanna and Professor Pablo Garcia-Pavia, alongside Australia's foremost amyloidosis clinicians and researchers. We anticipate approximately 150 medical and allied health attendees, representing the clinicians and services most directly involved in amyloidosis diagnosis and care nationally.



2. A national series of Patient, Family and Carer symposia

In addition to the medical congress, the AAN will deliver a coordinated program of state-based patient and carer symposia in Sydney, Brisbane, Perth, Adelaide and Melbourne. These meetings will provide accessible education for patients and families, with talks from international and local experts, and opportunities for connection with local physicians and amyloidosis services.

Each symposium is expected to attract approximately 70 patients, carers and local clinicians, creating a unique opportunity to support education, awareness and engagement across the amyloidosis community nationally.

This is a rare opportunity for sponsors to support the first truly national amyloidosis education program in Australia — reaching the clinicians who diagnose and treat amyloidosis, the multidisciplinary teams who deliver care, and the patients and families most affected by these diseases.

Terms & Conditions

Booking and Payment

All prices are quoted in Australian dollars and exclude GST (Goods and Services Tax). GST is required to be applied to all packages at the rate prevailing at the date of invoicing or payment, whichever is earlier (currently 10%).

Sponsorship packages and exhibition space will be allocated only upon receipt of the online booking form or a signed hard copy booking form (i.e. a first come, first served basis).

1. Confirmation with be sent together with a tax invoice for the required deposit, which is payable within 20 days of invoice date. The deposit will be 50% of the total package value being purchased, unless the amount is less than AUD\$10,000, where purchase amount will be invoiced in full. If the deposit is not received within this timeframe, you relinquish your right to the requested sponsorship package and exhibition space.
2. The balance will be invoiced on 12th Feb 2027, to be paid by 5th March 2027. Applications made after 12th Feb 2027 will be invoiced for full payment within 20 days.
3. All payments should be made in Australian dollars by credit card or bank transfer. Any payment by credit card will include a convenience fee of 2.6%.
4. All payments must be made prior to the start of the Conference. Access to the Exhibition Hall will be limited until payment is made or proof of payment is submitted.
5. Sponsors may not assign or sublet any part of their exhibition space.
6. Every attempt will be made to meet your preferred exhibition location. However, The Organising Committee reserves the right to re-assign locations if necessary following discussion with the affected parties.
7. Sponsors consent to their contact details being shared with Conference suppliers and contractors.

Cancellation Policy

If notification of cancellation of sponsorship is received in writing:

- Between November 13th and 12th March 2027; you are liable for 50% of the package selected.
- From 12th March 2027, you are liable for 100% of the package selected.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to cancel the Conference no later than 20 August 2026 in case of circumstances beyond its control. In such a case all monies paid to date will be refunded in full less any expenses incurred. The liability of the organisers will be limited to that amount.
