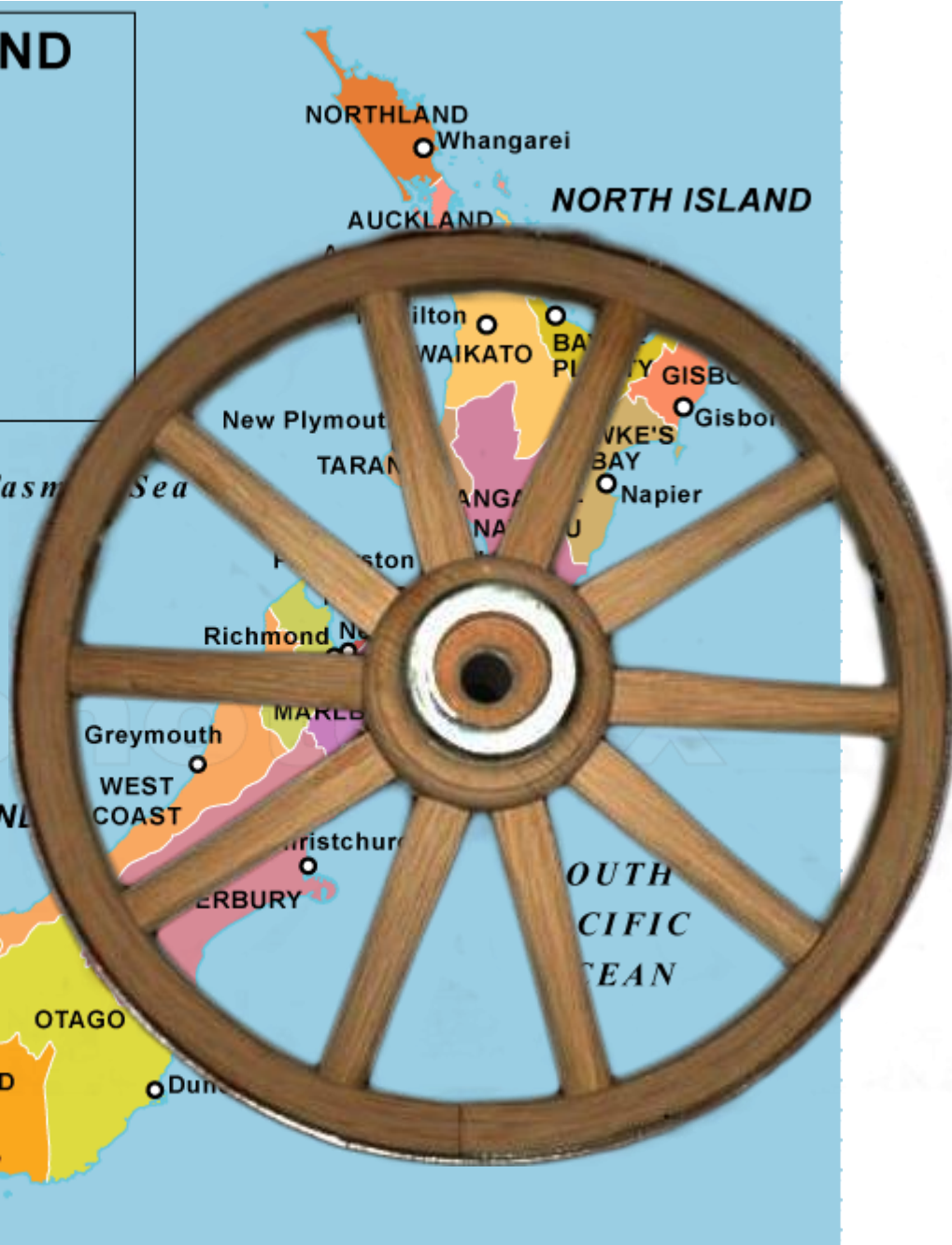

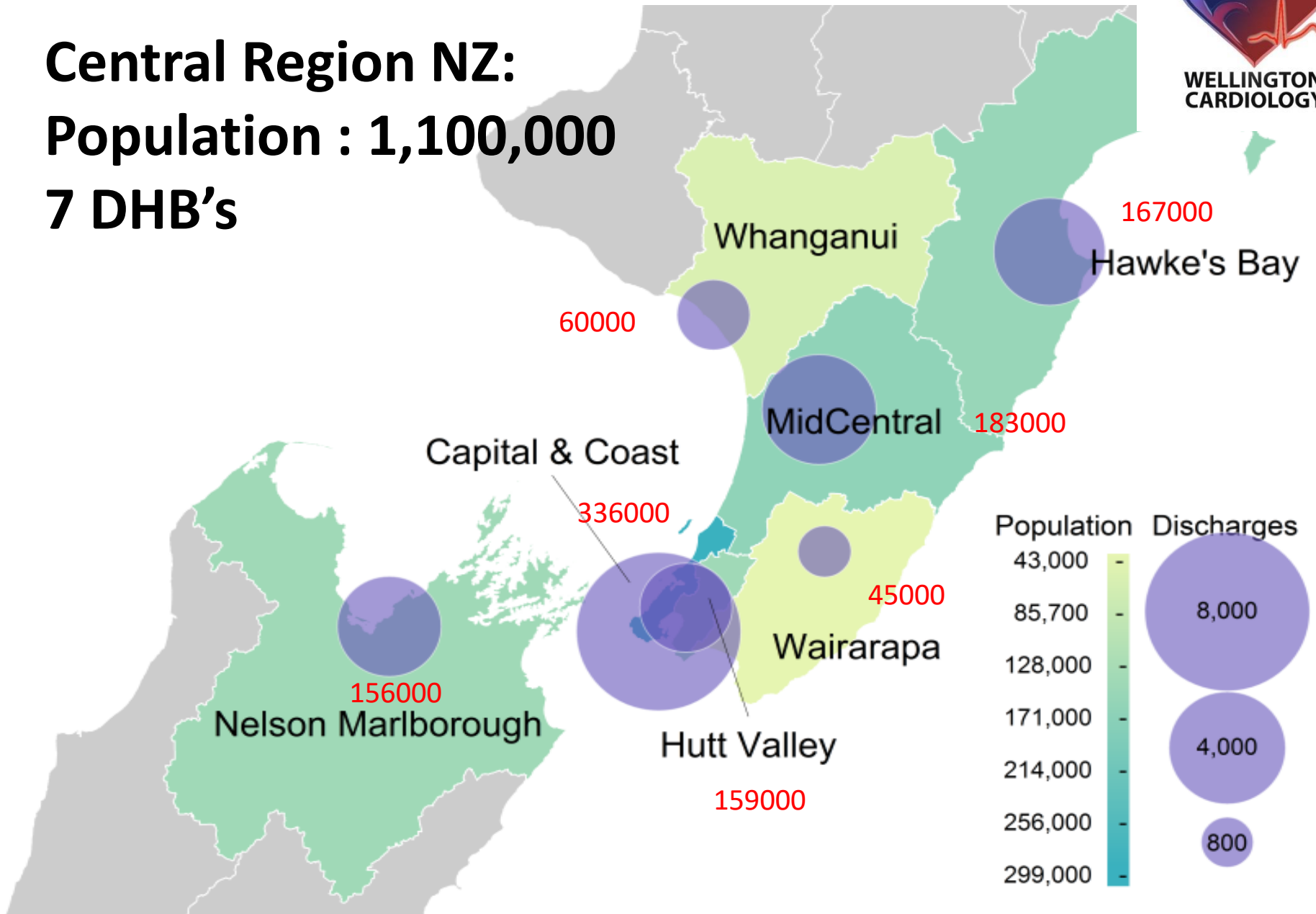

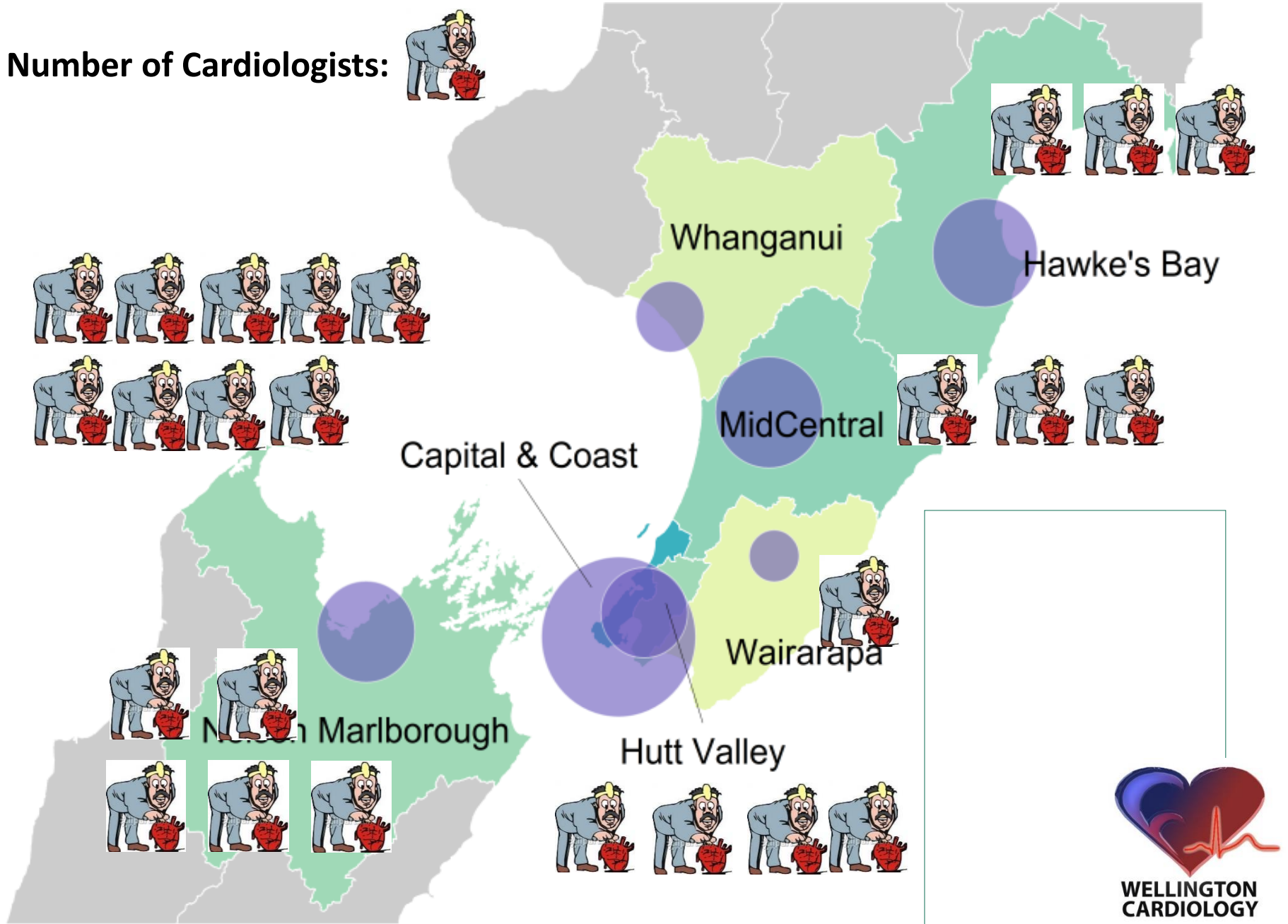

Central Region NZ: Population : 1,100,000 7 DHB's

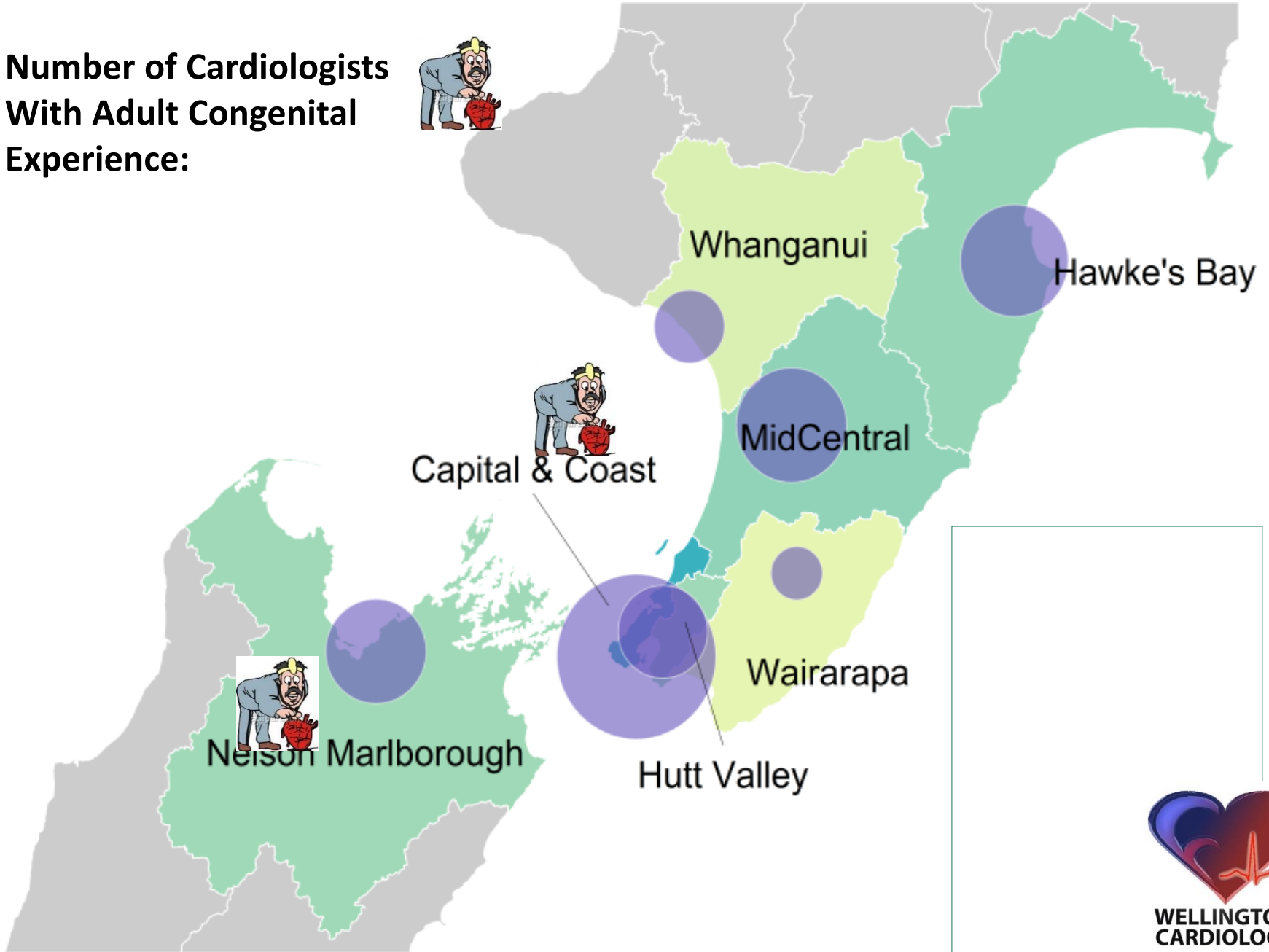

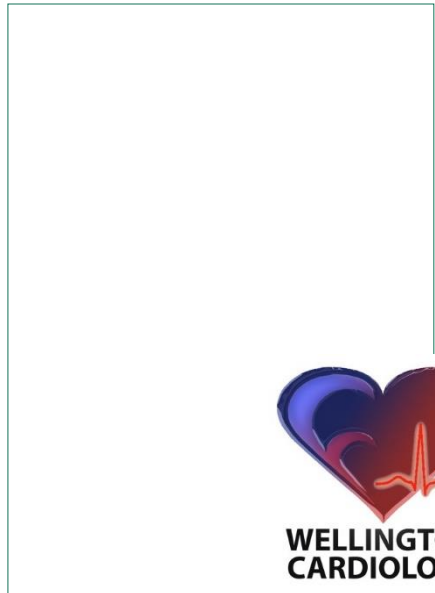
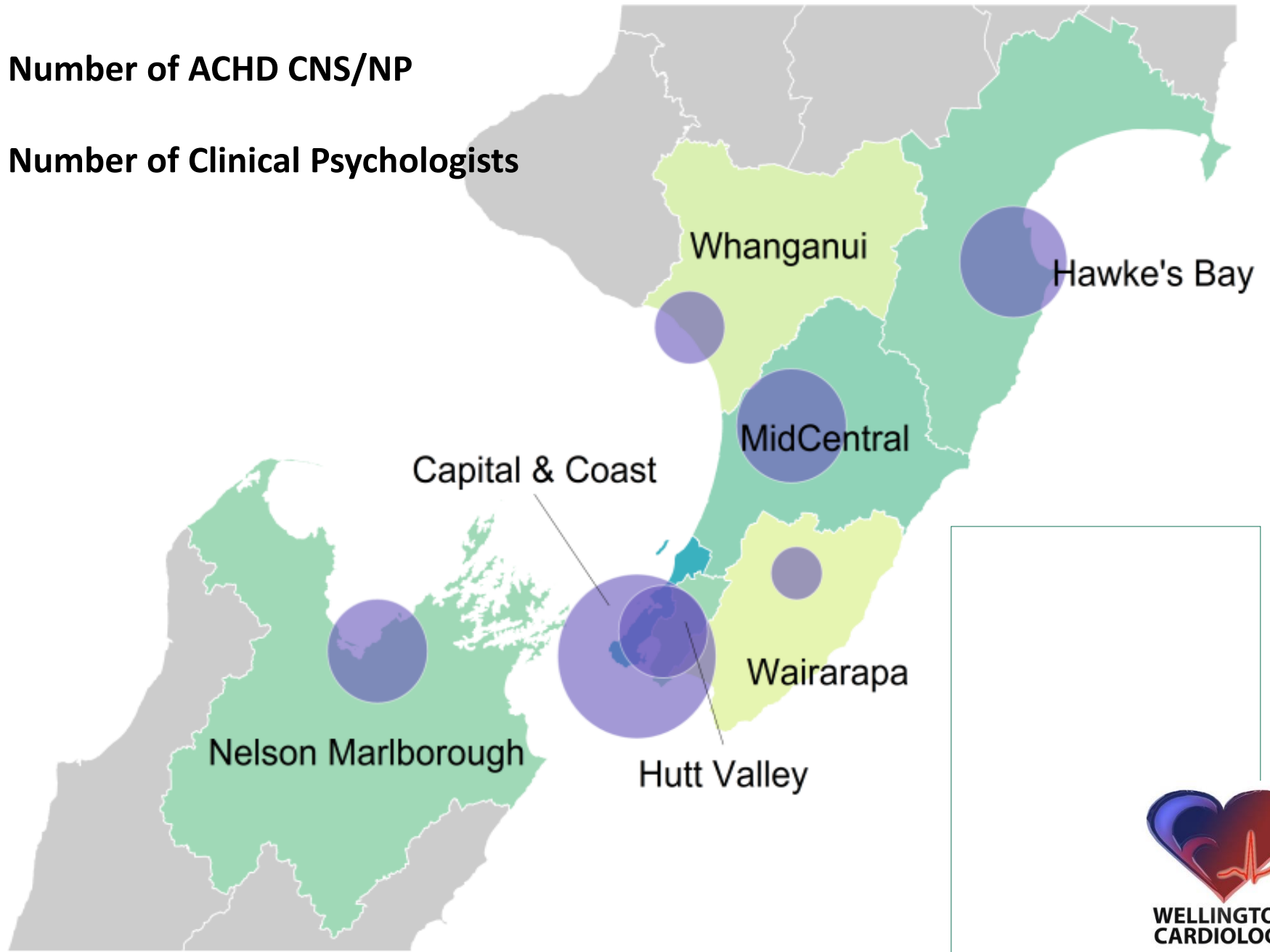

What Works ?

- Visiting Clinics
 - Need to be done with active input of local team
 - Physiologist support critical
 - ECHO
 - pacing
 - 'Local' health care providers to tie up loose ends

What Could Work ?

- Regional provision of care
 - Enhance regional resources

 - Streamline interaction with hub centre
 - Videoconference facility to discuss patients
 - Involvement in educational opportunities
- Encourage regional training in ACHD
 - Increase exposure of adult cardiology trainees
