OPTION 1: 4 HOURS / CULINARY MELBOURNE

MEETING POINT – SOUTHGATE OR GUEST HOTEL

Walk with us as we share stories about Melbourne's past & present. You will weave in and around the many laneways and arcades, understanding the rich food influences of mass immigration – that is unique to Melbourne.

TASTING MELBOURNE CHOCOLATE

Your first stop on your laneway journey is in Melbourne's Degrave's Street at Koko Black for some delicious, mouthwatering chocolate with distinct Australian flavour.

Continue your walk – visiting street art laneways, gaining insight into Melbourne's 'foodie' precinct, chefs and restaurateurs who have shaped Melbourne's culinary culture.

A SPANISH OR MEXICAN INFLUENCE

Stop in at one of Melbourne's iconic Spanish venues, Movida OR Modern Mexicana at Tres A Cinco, for surprising signature tastes. A short walk-through our favourite foodie precinct, Hosier Lane, Flinders Lane, Oliver Lane.

ASIAN FUSION WITH A TWIST

Time to delight in one of our Asian-Fusion venues, Lucy Liu. Learn how Asian culinary influences have shaped Melbourne into the vibrant and cultural city it is today. Continue strolling in and around our laneways.

COFFEE FIRST – MARKET LANE – QUEEN VICTORIA MARKET

Coffee of course, Melbourne style. We'll wander through our delicious market deli, cheese and fresh produce – before a stroll through the specialty clothing and craft stalls.

STREET ART MELBOURNE

We'll spend time with one of Melbourne's well known Street Artist – taking in the history of Street Art in Melbourne – gaining insight into the diversity and characters within Melbourne's Street Art community. A tram ride and stroll back to our laneways.

LANEWAYS & ARCADES

Weave in and around the many laneways and arcades – Southgate, Flinders Street, Centre Place, DeGrave's Street, Block Arcade, Royal Arcade, Hosier Lane, ACDC Lane and more.

COASTAL STOP, THE NOBBIES & SEAL ROCKS LOOKOUT

Overlook Seal Rocks – home to Australia’s largest fur seal colony. Time for photographs, a stroll along clifftop paths. Optional - visit to the Antarctic Journey interactive centre (add-on)

LUNCH – PHILLIP ISLAND

Stop for a light lunch at one of our favourite Phillip Island cafes

MOONLIT SANCTUARY WILDLIFE CONSERVATION PARK

Close-up encounters with koalas, kangaroos, wombats, dingoes and native birds (weather permitting) Great for international visitors seeking Australian wildlife interaction.

DINNER – COWES, PHILLIP ISLAND

Stop at Cowes township for a pub dinner or at the Penguin Parade Visitor Centre Café. Free time to dine, browse gift shops, or relax before the evening’s main event.

PHILLIP ISLAND NATURE PARKS – PENGUIN PARADE

Experience the award-winning visitor centre and explore interactive exhibits on penguin conservation. Proceed to allocated viewing area for sunset arrival of the Little Penguins. Watch hundreds of penguins waddle ashore to return to their burrows after a day at sea. General Viewing: Tiered seating with great visibility

DEPART PHILLIP ISLAND

After the parade concludes, return to the vehicle for a comfortable evening drive back to Melbourne.

We kick off our journey towards Melbourne's much loved Brighton Beach Boxes

VISIT BRIGHTON BEACH BOXES

Kick off your day with a visit to the famous Brighton Beach Boxes, located along the Melbourne coastline. These iconic, colorful bathing boxes have become a symbol of the city's beach culture, offering great photo opportunities and a relaxed start to your tour. Take in the views of the ocean and enjoy a few moments to explore the vibrant huts before we continue to the Mornington Peninsula.

SCENIC DRIVE TO MORNINGTON PENINSULA

After visiting the Brighton Beach Boxes, we'll embark on a scenic drive toward the Mornington Peninsula. Enjoy the rolling hills and vineyards as we make our way to the first winery stop.

WINE TASTING AT MONTALTO VINEYARD & OLIVE GROVE

Your first wine stop is Montalto Vineyard & Olive Grove, one of the most renowned wineries in the region. Montalto is famous for its Pinot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon (Bordeaux-style reds), and crisp Sauvignon Blanc. Their Pinot Noir is complex, with layers of red fruit, while their Sauvignon Blanc is fresh, light, and mineral-driven—matching your preference for a French-style wine. Montalto offers spectacular views of the vineyard, making it a perfect place to start your wine-tasting journey.

SCENIC DRIVE TO ARTHURS SEAT

After enjoying the wines at Montalto, we'll take a short scenic drive to Arthur's Seat, one of the highest points on the Peninsula. From here, you'll have breathtaking panoramic views of the Peninsula's vineyards and coastline. This is a great spot to take in the beauty of the region and snap a few memorable photos.

LUNCH AT PT. LEO ESTATE (OR SIMILAR)

Pt. Leo Estate is a renowned winery and vineyard located on the Mornington Peninsula in Victoria, Australia. Known for its breathtaking coastal views, the estate produces a variety of premium wines, including Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, and Shiraz. In addition to its world-class wines, Pt. Leo Estate offers visitors an exceptional experience with its contemporary architecture, sculpture park, and fine dining options.

WINE TASTING AT STONIER WINES

After lunch, we'll head to Stonier Wines, known for its exceptional Pinot Noir and Sauvignon Blanc. Stonier's Pinot Noir is refined and balanced, showcasing the cool-climate terroir of the Peninsula, while their Sauvignon Blanc is fresh, crisp, and herbaceous—just the kind of French-style Sauvignon Blanc you love. The winery offers a beautiful setting to continue your wine journey.

VISIT STINK & PLONK WINE & CHEESE SHOP

Next, we'll make our way to the charming town of Flinders to visit the Stink and Plonk Wine and Cheese Shop. This quirky and fun stop is perfect for discovering local, small-batch wines paired with artisanal cheeses. It's a relaxed, informal spot where you can chat with knowledgeable staff and sample hidden wine gems that may not be found at larger wineries.

WINE TASTING AT FOXEYS HANGOUT

Continue your tour with a visit to Foxey's Hangout, a boutique winery specializing in cool-climate wines. Known for their Pinot Noir, Sauvignon Blanc, and sparkling wines, Foxey's Hangout offers a tasting experience that reflects the Peninsula's cool-climate growing conditions. Their Pinot Noir is

light and structured, and their Sauvignon Blanc is fresh and vibrant with citrus and herbal notes, providing a refreshing end to your wine tastings.

After a memorable day of wine tastings, stunning views, and charming local sights, we'll drive you back to Melbourne, where you'll arrive relaxed and enriched by your exploration of the Mornington Peninsula's best wineries.

PICK UP FROM YOUR CENTRAL MELBOURNE CBD HOTEL

MORNING TEA AT GRANTS PICNIC GROUND

Stop at this tranquil spot surrounded by tall Mountain Ash trees. Hand-feed native parrots such as crimson rosellas and king parrots. Enjoy tea/coffee and fresh scones with jam & cream at the café

PUFFING BILLY STEAM TRAIN RIDE (BELGRAVE TO LAKESIDE)

Board the iconic Puffing Billy steam train at Belgrave Station. Enjoy a 1-hour journey through lush fern gullies and towering forest to Lakeside Station in Emerald. Photo opportunities abound as the train winds along trestle bridges and forested hillsides.

LAKESIDE PARK EXPLORATION & OPTIONAL PADDLE BOATS

Free time to stroll around Emerald Lake Park, a picturesque picnic and lake setting. Optional short paddle boat ride or visit the Puffing Billy Lakeside Visitor Centre.

LUNCH AT A LOCAL DANDENONG RANGES CAFÉ OR WINERY

Enjoy a relaxed 2-course lunch at a scenic venue.

SHOPPING IN SASSAFRAS OR OLINDA

Visit one of the charming hilltop villages known for local crafts, boutiques, and garden stores. Great stop for souvenirs and sweet treats at Miss Marple's or Sassafras Sweet Co.

A SCENIC FINISH

Scenic Drive & Garden Lookout - Optional visit to a lookout such as Mount Dandenong Observatory, or brief walk-through Alfred Nicholas Memorial Garden or William Ricketts Sanctuary (subject to season open times).
