

NGO and Non-profit Campaigns: Organizations that effectively communicate about sustainability (online platforms, social media campaigns, and interactive workshops).



Do We Understand Heat and Urban Heat Island?

Urbanization and industrialization improve our material lives and comfort; But do you know they also induce other problems to human beings, such as global warming, industrial waste, and air pollution? The most important challenges which impact on urban environment and leads cities forward unsustainable is the heat related issue; known as urban heat island (UHI) phenomenon. An urban heat island occurs when a city experiences much warmer temperatures than nearby rural areas.


The well-balanced combination of education and entertainment contributes to a variety of programs with creative, informative and entertaining value for the benefit of audiences and society.


