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# Erasmus+ supporting Austr(al)ia cooperation

- Erasmus+ Mobility
  - for students going either way between our countries with financial support for a study abroad period (2 – 12 months) or a study-related internship;
  - for **university staff** on teaching assignment or for professional training;
  - for short term mobility (Blended Intensive Programmes, summer school-like);
  - funding: mobility allowance + travel grant
- Strategic dimension involved
  - Erasmus+ aims at supporting universities in Europe to "internationalise"
  - Participation involves credit transfer (and recognition) & quality assurance



- View from the Gaisberg, one of Salzburg's city mountains – 1,667m
- Highest mountain in the Salzburg region: Großvenediger – 3,666m



#### Why partnerships with Asia and the Pacific Regions?

- Change of global demographics
- Increasing mobility demands: towards Asia and the Pacific Region
- Increasing global student mobility (degree-seeking students)
- Higher education as a global market
- Changing role of governments and education and research politics:
  - (1) European Union as key stakeholder (programmes Horizon Europe, Erasmus+)
  - (2) Autonomy of Austrian universities
  - (3) Austrian ministry invests in global university networks for ASEAN and Asia Pacific Regions national funds for joint research projects
- Increasing non-traditional teaching models in higher education
- Strategic alliances (institutional, national and European)
- Demand from employers/employees



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#### Why a strategic partnership with the University of Melbourne?

- Academic specialisations complement each other:
  - Academic collaboration in research, joint teaching, student exchange, doctoral training initiatives, development of joint summer schools and hybrid workshops
  - Literary, Linguistic, and Cultural Studies as focus of partnership
  - UoM School of Languages and Linguistics: special focus on Translation Studies, Exile and Travel Literature, Critical Theory, Indigenous Studies.
  - Both universities offer Environmental Humanities
  - PLUS Faculty of Arts: teaching expertise with great historical depth, applied research in arts, archiving, editing, arts and literature promotion
  - Both PLUS and UOM also collaborate with top-ranked universities around the world (Oxford, Yale, Harvard, Cambridge) in Musicology, Classical Philology, Ancient History, Literary and Cultural Studies networking synergies!



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# International Strategy



- New strategy 'Advancing Melbourne Globally' launched 2024
- UoM = 248 exchange partnerships
- Semester exchange program –1500 annually
- Increasing post covid, last semester 1000+
- Funding Melbourne Mobility Awards
- Europe + UK most popular



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# Partnerships Process

- Proposals via Faculty or central division
- University-wide require 3 faculties to support
- Global Strategy Forum
- Erasmus Plus important marker of a successful European partnership
- Testing ground for developing strong Faculty relationships
- Recruiting students = support from Faculty


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# UoM + PLUS
