Discover Adelaide City on a 3-hour morning coach tour that details the history and highlights of the cosmopolitan capital city of South Australia. A perfect introduction for first-time visitors, this tour covers the Botanic Park, Adelaide Oval, St Peters Cathedral, a stop at Colonel William Lights statue for a fantastic view over the city and a visit to the National Wine Centre of Australia.

Hotel pickup is included. 3-hour city tour by coach of Adelaide Learn about the top attractions and districts in Adelaide.

1pm pickup. This activity ends back at the meeting point at 5pm.

After morning pickup from select hotels in central Adelaide, board the coach for your city tour. Tour through the cultural precinct of Adelaide, including the North Terrace, Adelaide Botanic Gardens, the National Wine Centre, and the Botanic Park — home to the Adelaide Zoo and Bicentennial Conservatory. Continue travelling along tree-lined streets in historic North Adelaide where your guide shares the history of the mansions and historic buildings that you pass. A stop will be made at the National Wine Centre of Australia, located on the edge of Adelaide's stunning Botanic Gardens where you will have free time to explore the Wine Discovery Journey Museum. Your morning will also include a visit to the iconic St Peters Cathedral (subject to availability) After three hours, come back to the city centre via the South Parklands, West Terrace, and North Terrace. Your tour ends with a return to either Elder Park, Rundle Mall or Adelaide Central Bus Station.
