ISHR / CSANZ Student Investigator Prizes





Student registrants can be considered for oral (may include free communication), mini-oral and/or poster presentation prizes in this category.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Applicants must be an undergraduate student (including medical student, bio/science honours student) OR a non-medical graduate student (ie PhD, Masters), involved in research activity. Graduates of medical or other equivalent clinical degrees who are undertaking higher degrees are not eligible.
- 2. Applicants must be a current ISHR Student financial member.
- 3. The applicant must be the first and presenting author on the abstract.
- 4. The applicant must have made a significant contribution to the concept and execution of the work being presented.
- 5. The work must be substantially new and must NOT have been previously presented at a Cardiac Society/ISHR Annual Scientific Meeting.
- 6. A previous winner in any specific Student Investigator Prize category is ineligible to compete in the same category.
- 7. An applicant may not compete for an ISHR Student Investigator Prize and a Ralph Reader Prize or CSANZ ASM Prize (and will be asked to choose which they would like to be shortlisted for if initially deemed competitive in more than one prize).
- 8. Prizes are awarded by a panel of judges but will only be awarded if a contribution is considered to be of sufficient merit.
- 9. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
