

## 2020 CSANZ Annual Scientific Meeting Prizes

A Prize will be awarded to the best individual presentation by a CSANZ young investigator in each themed prize session at the Annual Scientific Meeting of the Cardiac Society of Australia and New Zealand.

The themed prizes are as follows:

- Cardiac Imaging Prize
- Cardiovascular Genetic Diseases Prize
- Clinical Trials Prize
- Heart Rhythm Prize

- Heart Failure Prize
- Indigenous Health Prize
- Paediatric and Congenital Prize
- Prevention Prize

## **Eligibility Criteria**

- 1. The applicant must be domiciled in Australia or New Zealand.
- 2. The applicant must be a Member of CSANZ or have submitted an application for membership by the abstract submission deadline.
- 3. The applicant must not be more than six years post-PhD or postgraduate qualification as at the abstract submission deadline.
- 4. The work must be substantially new and have been carried out in Australia or New Zealand. The applicant must have made a significant contribution to the concept and execution of the work.
- 5. Submissions for the Prize session are restricted to a **single paper only**.
- 6. Prior to the abstract submission deadline, the abstract must NOT have been published or accepted for publication or have been previously presented at a national meeting or World Congress held in Australia or New Zealand.
- 7. The applicant <u>must</u> provide a detailed letter of support from the supervisor or Director of the laboratory or service from which the work has emanated, clearly detailing the following information:
  - the applicant's position (advanced trainee, researcher, post-doc etc)
  - details about the contribution made by the applicant towards the work being presented.
  - new work specific to the submission
  - any previous presentations of the work
  - distinguish work previously performed in the supervisor's laboratory or department
- 11. Supporting documents are to be emailed to the CSANZ Secretariat <u>info@csanz.edu.au</u> by the abstract submission deadline. Failure to provide the letter from the Supervisor will result in the paper being <u>withdrawn</u> from consideration for the Prize session.
- 12. If an abstract is submitted for a prize session and is not accepted, it is automatically considered for presentation in the general Scientific Meeting.
- 13. Each themed prize is valued at AUD\$1,000 and is awarded by a panel of judges but will only be awarded if a contribution is considered to be of sufficient merit. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
