



## Prof Scott Harding

Professor Harding is an Interventional Cardiologist and the Director of Cardiology Research at Wellington Hospital, Wellington, New Zealand. He is an Adjunct Professor at the School of Biological Sciences, Victoria University, Wellington and a past chairman of the New Zealand Interventional Working Group. Professor Harding undertook cardiology training in Wellington Hospital, New Zealand and the Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh,

United Kingdom before undertaking an Interventional Fellowship at the Massachusetts General Hospital, Boston, USA.

His major interventional interests are treatment of chronic total coronary occlusions, treatment of complex coronary lesions and intravascular imaging. Professor Harding has lectured on and proctored CTO and complex internationally and has expertise in anterograde wiring, retrograde and anterograde dissection re-entry techniques. Current research interests include CTO PCI, intravascular imaging, acute coronary syndromes, coronary intervention, platelet biology and antiplatelet agents.
