YOUNG INVESTIGATORS AWARD

Guidelines for Entrants

There will be 1 up to \$7,500 prize for costs to attend an international ASM within two years awarded to the best individual presentation by an investigator at the Annual Scientific Meeting of the Cardiac Society.

CONDITIONS

1. Applicants must be Advanced Trainees or Research Fellows in cardiology or cardiac surgery, or nurses, cardiac technologists, cardiac sonographers and other health professionals with an interest in cardiovascular medicine or surgery or research in these or allied subjects.
Applicants must still be in training.
2. The applicant must be domiciled in Australia or New Zealand.
3. The Award is not restricted to Members of the Society.
4. The work must have been carried out in Australia or New Zealand and the applicant must have made a significant contribution to the concept and execution of the work.
5. **The applicant must include with their abstract submission a letter from the supervisor or Director of the laboratory or service from which the work has emanated**, clearly detailing the specific contribution made by the applicant towards the work being presented
6. If an abstract is submitted for the Young Investigator Award, and is not accepted, it is automatically considered for presentation in the general Scientific Meeting. The applicant must be prepared to present it in this category instead.
7. Investigators may submit only **one** abstract for the Young Investigator Award category each year.
8. The prize will be awarded by a panel of judges but will only be awarded if a contribution is considered to be of sufficient merit.
9. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
