Registration Terms and Conditions

- All prices are in New Zealand dollars and include Goods and Services Tax of 15%.
- If you cancel your registration prior to 3 February 2023 you will receive a refund less a cancellation fee of NZ\$100.00. Cancellations made after 3 February 2023 will not be refunded.
- Full payment for registration fees must be received prior to the Symposium.
- The Privacy Act 2020 provides that, before your name and contact details can be published in a list of participants you must give your consent. If you select 'Yes, I do want my details to be included in the list of participants' on the registration form or by email, your details may be distributed to:
