
PASL – we can open a file

Statistically unlikely to need help

- Out of about 1200 members, in 2020 we;
 - Advised about 60 principals on matters affecting their employment under the Hotline
 - Heard about 30 Board or operational matters causing concern to the principal
 - Had 17 files open







Principal T


- Long serving and well regarded close to retirement
- New Presiding Member (PM) and new staff rep (DP)
- Solicitation of complaints and concerns principal gave notice she was "retiring"
- Further allegations with 2 weeks to go ("serious misconduct")
- PASL: Letter to the principal designed to be given to the Board
- Principal met with PM several times to discuss the issues, with PASL in the background
- Withdrawal of all complaints, so no risk of mandatory report
- A happier retirement function




