Delegates

The Symposium is aimed at all medical professionals who have an interest in Cardiac Arrest and Sports Cardiology. These two topics are separate but with important overlap. The Sports Cardiology program in 2025 will focus on topics such as:

- » hypertrophic cardiomyopathy
- » coronary disease in the middle-aged athlete
- » atrial fibrillation and other arrhythmias and the athlete.

The Cardiac Arrest program will focus on:

- » triggers for cardiac arrest
- » post-arrest care
- » and a global approach to cardiac arrest.

Overlap themes include advanced cardiac imaging and genetics.

The program provides several interactive elements including a case study "Mont Ventoux to the cath lab table", and a demonstration of "Jo Average" vs "Jo Elite" using cardiopulmonary exercise testing.

The overlap between the Saturday Sports Cardiology program and Sunday's Cardiac Arrest agenda is designed such that there will be interest for those outside of their key interest realm.

In 2025 we are introducing a training day on Friday afternoon for cardiology registrars and others interested in learning techniques for imaging and exercise testing in active patients.

Cardiologists, Sports Physicians, General Practitioners, Cardiac Physiologists and Trainees in Cardiology or Sports and Exercise Medicine would be expected to find interest in symposium content. We anticipate that the Symposium will attract approximately 150 delegates from the local area and interstate.

Booking and Payment

All prices are quoted in Australian dollars and exclude GST (Goods and Services Tax). GST is required to be applied to all packages at the rate prevailing at the date of invoicing or payment, whichever is earlier (currently 10%).

Sponsorship packages and exhibition space will be allocated only upon receipt of the online booking form or a signed hard copy booking form (i.e. a first come, first served basis).

- 1. Confirmation with be sent together with a tax invoice for the required deposit, which is payable within 20 days of invoice date. The deposit will be 50% of the total package value being purchased, unless the amount is less than AUD\$5,000, where purchase amount will be invoiced in full. If the deposit is not received within this timeframe, you relinquish your right to the requested sponsorship package and exhibition space.
- The balance will be invoiced on 03 November 2024, to be paid by 10 December 2024.
 Applications made after 10 December will be invoiced for full payment within 20 days.
- 3. All payments should be made in Australian dollars by credit card or bank transfer.

 Any payment by credit card will include a convenience fee of 2.6%.
- 4. All payments must be made prior to the start of the Symposium. Access to the Exhibition Hall will be limited until payment is made or proof of payment is submitted.
- 5. Sponsors may not assign or sublet any part of their exhibition space.
- 6. Every attempt will be made to meet your preferred exhibition location. However, The Organising Committee reserves the right to re-assign locations if necessary following discussion with the affected parties.
- 7. Sponsors consent to their contact details being shared with Symposium suppliers and contractors.

Cancellation Policy

If notification of cancellation of sponsorship is received in writing:

- » Between 1st July 2024 and 31st December 2024, you are liable for 50% of the package selected.
- » From 1st January 2025 you are liable for 100% of the package selected.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to cancel the Symposium no later than 31st January 2025 in case of circumstances beyond its control. In such a case all monies paid to date will be refunded in full less any expenses incurred. The liability of the organisers will be limited to that amount.
