
#### **Meeting Venue**





### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

#### **BOOKING AND PAYMENT**

All prices are quoted in Australian dollars and exclude GST (Goods and Services Tax). GST is required to be applied to all packages (if you are a resident in Australia) at the rate prevailing at the date of invoicing or payment, whichever is earlier (currently 10%).

Sponsorship packages and exhibition space will be allocated only on receipt of the booking form or a signed hard copy booking form (i.e. a first come, first served basis).

Confirmation will be sent together with a tax invoice for the required 50% deposit. The deposit is payable within 20 days of date of tax invoice. If the deposit is not received within this timeframe then you relinquish your right to the requested sponsor package and exhibition space.

The balance will be invoiced on 1 June 2023, to be paid by 21 June 2023. Applications made after 21 June 2023 must include full payment.

All payments should be made in Australian dollars by credit card (fees applicable) or bank transfer.

All payments due must be received by the Meeting Managers prior to the Meeting. No sponsor will be allowed to set up their exhibition stand at the Meeting until full payment has been received.

Sponsors may not assign or sublet any part of their exhibition space.

The Organising Committee may need to make changes to the floor plan, however, changes will not be undertaken without prior discussion with the companies affected.

Sponsors consent to their contact details being shared with Meeting suppliers and contractors.

#### **CANCELLATION POLICY**

In the event of cancellation received by you in writing after 28 March 2023 and prior to 30 May 2023, you are liable for 50% of the sponsorship package selected.

In the event of cancellation received by you in writing after 30 May, you are liable for 100% of the sponsorship package selected.

After sponsorship has been confirmed and accepted, a reduction in sponsorship by you is considered a cancellation.

In the event that the in-person meeting is cancelled and Sleep DownUnder proceeds as a virtual-only meeting, you are able to either:

- Cancel your participation according to the terms below, or
- Take up a virtual sponsorship package with the fee differential either refunded or credited towards participation in the 2024 meeting.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to cancel the entire meeting or in-person element in case of circumstances beyond its control

- If the cancellation is prior to 29 September 2023, all monies paid to date will be refunded in full. The liability of the Organisers will be limited to that amount.
- If the cancellation is after 29 September 2023, a 20% service fee will be deducted from sponsorship package selected with the balance refunded.

If the Organising Committee cancels the entire meeting or in-person element we will not be liable for any expenses incurred by you in preparation of material for the meeting or the supply of goods and services.

#### MEDICINES AUSTRALIA CODE OF CONDUCT

In the event of a transition to a full virtual meeting format due to Covid-19 related government or state restrictions you will be provided with the opportunity to transfer to a virtual sponsorship package of an equivalent level, with any difference in price refunded.
