## TSANZ AWARD Travel Grant ASM 2024

**Deadline for applications: 19 October 2023**

<b>Aim</b>	These travel awards are made available to encourage eligible TSANZ members to attend and enrich the Annual Scientific Meeting (ASM) through presentation of their work and active participation in the meeting. They are awarded to eligible applicants planning to pursue a career in respiratory medicine or related fields, based on the quality of the abstract submitted for presentation to the ASM.
<b>Eligibility Criteria</b>	<b>To be eligible for the award, the applicant must:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Be a current member of the TSANZOF<sup>1</sup>,</li><li>2. A citizen or permanent resident of Australia or New Zealand,</li><li>3. Be earning a pro-rata salary of less than AU \$80,000 p.a. gross (to be certified by the applicant's supervisor/head of department), and</li><li>4. Be submitting an abstract as a presenting author for the TSANZ ASM.</li></ol>
<b>Conditions</b>	<b>The following conditions apply to this award:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The award must be used to support attendance at the TSANZSRS 2024.</li><li>• Travel items include appropriate transportation (car hire, bus, flights, train, sea vessel), transfers (taxi, ferry, etc.), and accommodation. Additional requests can be made in writing to the Research Chair.</li><li>• Funds may not be used to cover any overhead costs levied by the Administering Institution.</li></ul> <p><i>Note: These conditions must be met to remain eligible for future award rounds.</i></p>
<b>Applications</b>	Applicants must submit only an electronic application as a single PDF file via the <b>online abstract submission portal</b> .  In order to be considered for this award, your application <u>must</u> be submitted <i>by the deadline</i> and <u>must</u> include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A copy of the abstract to be submitted as presenting author to the TSANZ ASM;</li><li>• A certification of salary completed by supervisor/head of department.</li></ul>

## TSANZ AWARD Travel Grant ASM 2023

<b><i>Selection Process</i></b>	<p>The TSANZ Research Committee will allocate a travel grant to each eligible applicant, with the amount reflecting the distance the applicant needs to travel to attend the ASM and any sponsorship that the applicant may receive.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Only one travel grant to the TSANZ ASM will be awarded to an applicant in each year, irrespective of the number of abstracts submitted.</li><li>• The maximum number of travel grants that may be awarded to a given applicant attending multiple TSANZ ASMs is <b>three</b> grants.</li></ul>
