### TSANZ AWARD Japanese Respiratory Society Early Career Development Award

#### Deadline for applications: 19 October 2023

Aim	This Early Career Development Award is designed to reward, encourage and provide international exposure to promising, recent, advanced trainees/higher degree graduates. The award will cover the recipient's expenses (return economy airfare to Japan, registration, accommodation, living expenses) to attend and present at the Annual Scientific Meeting of the Japanese Respiratory Society in the following year.
Eligibility Criteria	<ul> <li>To be eligible for the award, the applicant must:</li> <li>1. Be a current member of TSANZ<sup>1</sup>,</li> <li>2. A citizen or permanent resident of Australia or New Zealand, or have the requisite work or study visa and be endorsed by the Administering Institution<sup>2</sup>,</li> </ul>
	EARLY CAREER GRANT
	3. Be undertaking advanced training in any health or science discipline relevant to respiratory medicine research or a higher degree in an area directly relevant to respiratory research, or
	4. Have completed advanced training in any health or science discipline or graduated with a higher degree in an area directly relevant to respiratory research within the last five years of the closing date for this application.
	<ol> <li>Be submitting an abstract for an oral presentation as a presenting author for the TSANZ ASM, and</li> <li>Be available to attend the JRS ASM to be held in the following year to make an oral presentation on their work or in their area of expertise.</li> </ol>
	Previous recipients of this award are not eligible to apply.
Condition	The following conditions must be meet by members receiving this award:
	<ul> <li>The award must be used to attend the JRS ASM the following year.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Recipients are required to submit a report within 2 months of attendance at JRS, for publication in the TSANZ newsletter and to be shared with JRS.</li> </ul>
	Note: These conditions must be met to remain eligible for future award rounds.
Applications	<ul> <li>Applicants must submit only an electronic application as a PDF file via the online abstract submission portal. In order to be considered for this award, your application must be submitted by the deadline and must include:</li> <li>One TSANZSRS2024 abstract as your nomination for this award.</li> </ul>
