Eligibility
Criteria

To be eligible for the award, the applicant must:

1. Be a current member of TSANZ ${ }^{1}$,
2. A citizen or permanent resident of Australia or New Zealand, or have the requisite work or study visa and be endorsed by the Administering Institution ${ }^{2}$,
3. Be undertaking a higher degree by research in an area directly relevant to respiratory research, or
4. Have graduated with a higher degree in research in an area directly relevant to respiratory research within the last two years of the closing date for this application - career interruptions should be specified in track record,
5. Submit an original abstract for oral presentation as presenting author for the TSANZ ASM, and
6. Be responsible for the major components of the work to be presented (to be certified by the applicant's supervisor/head of department)

The research to be presented must have been carried out:
7. In Australia and/or New Zealand,
8. During the candidate's first substantive research project or program and must be directly relevant to respiratory research, and
9. Over a period of two years or more, full time equivalent.

Note: New Investigator finalists may only apply in subsequent years if their extended abstract is substantially different to the previous application ${ }^{3}$.
