

# Reducing the risk of travel

## Biosecurity Quick Tips



### BEFORE LEAVING HOME

Familiarise yourself with New Zealand biosecurity requirements. Carefully consider your answers and information provided on the NZ Traveler Declaration form. **We have a lot to protect.**

### Before entering farm



#### Confirm farm disease status

Your host will confirm that the farm has no suspected or confirmed notifiable animal diseases before your tour.



#### No contact with animals

DO NOT have contact with animals, raw milk or milking parlour.



#### Wear protective gear

Always wear coveralls, site provided footwear OR boot covers on farm. Eye protection is recommended.



#### Minimise equipment

Limit equipment and personal items, e.g. phone, camera etc., only take essentials.

### Leaving farm



#### Wash your hands

Wash and sanitise your hands regularly.



#### Clean equipment

Any equipment taken on the farm must be cleaned using sanitising wipes. **Do not take anything from the farm.**



#### Leave protective gear

All footwear, boot covers, and coveralls **MUST** remain on farm. Any personal protective eyewear etc is to be sanitised.



#### Footwear & clothing

Inspect shoes before leaving, clean and sanitise if any visible soiling. Remove clothing for washing if soiled. Always use footbaths provided.
